What to Bring?!



FOR SURE:

- Beach towel
- Blanket or something to sit on
- Clothing appropriate for mass
- Extra change of clothing
- Sweater or jacket
- Swimsuit
- Food Money (in case you want to buy, there is a snack booth)
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- Any prescription medications you are taking. Note: all medications must be turned in to your Youth Minister at check-in for the event.

DON'T EVEN THINK ABOUT IT:

- Drugs and/or alcohol
- Weapons
- Valuables (if you do bring, we are not responsible for loss or theft)
- Tobacco/Cigarettes

DRESS CODE – THIS IS A CHURCH EVENT:

No inappropriate graphics/wording on clothing.

For Girls:

Mini-skirts can only be worn with swimsuit underneath
No thong swimsuits
No string bikinis

For Guys:

No saggy jeans
No speedos

As adult leaders, should we feel that a person's clothing is inappropriate, we reserve the right to ask him or her to change their clothing. If they have nothing appropriate to change into, we will provide t-shirts to wear over them.

IMPORTANT BEACH RULES:

- Keep event bracelet on at all times
- Stay in groups, especially when in the water
- Do not go out too far into the water
- Do not wander off from group site; stay within the boundaries set by leaders
- No purpling (no public displays of affection: holding hands is okay)
- Do not forget to put on sunscreen
